Delaware Valley University and Northern York County School District**


Northern High School students who successfully complete the Agriculture Science curriculum can receive college credit from Delaware Valley University for the following courses:

- PS 1120 (3 credits) Sustainability: Saving the Earth and Feeding the People. This course satisfies 3 credits within the Plant Science majors.
- AS 1000 (3 credits) — Survey of Animal Agriculture. This course satisfies requirements 3 credits within the Animal Science major.

Acceptance of the curriculum by Delaware Valley University for these credits is based on the following:


- Northern High School students must successfully complete the Agriculture Science curriculum with a “B” average or better (3.0 GPA on a 4 point scale).
- Submit an official transcript to the Delaware Valley University Transfer Coordinator,
