What is bullying?

Bullying is a form of aggression in which:

- The behavior is intended to harm or cause distress
- The behavior occurs repeatedly over time
- There is an imbalance of power or strength among the parties

Bullying can be direct or indirect.

- Direct bullying uses physical or verbal attacks.
- Indirect bullying uses subtle negative interactions either in person or online.


NMS Rules Against Bullying
