Dear Fifth Grade Families,

One of the reading resources that we often use in class is a website/app called Epic. This website offers electronic books for students to read during their independent 'free' reading time in class. This resource is available free to teachers, but it is normally a paid monthly subscription for at-home access.

Epic has now offered free at-home access from now until June 30! If you are interested in this opportunity for your child to read on an electronic device at home, I will need to send you the link via email. I will be working to send these emails out to all fifth grade parents, using the email address that is provided in Sapphire. If you do not receive this email and you are interested, please send me a message on Seesaw with your email address included.

Once you receive the email, you will need to click on the link and create a password. No credit card information is required. On a computer, students can read directly in a web browser. On a phone or tablet, the free app will need to be downloaded.

There are many books of varying levels, including "Read to Me" books where it reads and tracks the text, and audiobooks where the book is read aloud, but the text is not available to view.
