

# MRS. GROVE'S ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

I hope that you are all staying healthy and safe during this challenging time. Below is an optional list of ideas and resources that can be completed at home. **Please know that these activities are not required** and are just a list of learning activities that are intended to support student engagement at home.

On 03/13/2020, a packet of information, supplies, and activities were sent home. **Those activities are also not required**. The packet contained information on how students can log in to **ClassLink** from home. On ClassLink, students are able to access Ji-JI (ST MATH), Headsprout (Learning A-Z), and Brain Pop Jr (Educational videos for students to watch about various subjects and topics).

#### **READING PRACTICE:**

- Read sight words on student word ring
  - o Read them to self, sibling, pet, parent/grandparent, etc
- Practice letter names and letter sounds
- Pick items from around the house and identify the beginning and/or the end sound
- Complete Headsprout (on the internet- you can access it thorough ClassLink)
- Listen to Nim's Island recordings, located on our school website.
- Find items in your house that start with certain letters/sounds, and/or items that end with certain letters/sounds.

#### WRITING/FINE MOTOR PRACTICE:

- Color, while lying on your belly
- Build something creative with Legos
- Form letters using playdoh
- Complete a Puzzle with your family
- Draw a picture about something you have done in the last few days
- Write a sentence about something you have done in the last few days
- Write the letters of the alphabet in the air, on your bed, on the carpet, in the grass, etc.

### **MATH PRACTICE:**

## Feel free to use any/all of the manipulatives that were sent home on Friday.

- Math flash cards
- Skip count by 2's, 5's, 10's.
- Count on from a teen number.
- Count to 20, 50, 100!
- Identify numbers you see on items around your house
- Find various numbers on the hundred chart. Which number is greater? Which number is less?
- Count and add items that you have around the house
  - o How many shoes do you have?
  - o How many pens do you have?
  - o How many pets do you have?
  - o How many cars have driven by your house?
