

SPEECH - ARTICULATION ACTIVITIES

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If your child works on a particular speech sound, please consider engaging in the following activities with your child:

ACTIVITY 1 - Play a board game with your child. In order for your child to take a turn, have him/her say a word with his/her sound and put that word in a sentence. If you do not have board games, then have your child say a word with his/her sound and put that word in a sentence to earn 2 minutes of free time on a video game or lpad or other preferred activity.

ACTIVITY 2 - Have your child walk around the house and find items that contain his/her speech sound in the word. Have your child say the words and put each word in a sentence. For each word (specific sound), your child gets a tally. For each word you provide, you get a tally! Who will have more tallies?!

ACTIVITY 3 - For younger readers or children not yet reading chapter books, have your child give you a sentence about each page of his/her book. Correct his/her grammar and target speech sound. For children reading chapter books, have your child find words with his/her target speech sound and read aloud those specific words.

ACTIVITY 4 – Play Hangman, Tic Tac Toe, Bingo, and other fun games with your child using words with his/her target speech sound.
