


## **BUDGET & FINANCES**

DASD = 23.7150

NYCSD = 18.7339 (21-22 tax increase was not caused by the addition of WT)



DASD = 21,814

NYCSD = 16,834

#### Future Capital Needs:

Currently, capacity in NYCSD buildings is enough to house WT students without the use of trailers or other temporary means. A task force has been put together to look at the existing need for a Middle School renovation and other large capital projects that will need to be addressed in the next 1-3 years.
