
## Orthographic Mapping with Sight Words

I. Say the word. Student repeats the word.




- 2. Finger spell to count the phonemes.
- 3. Place that many chips on the squares of the board.



4. Teacher writes the word on a white board or paper. Repeat the word, then say the sounds as you underline the letters that represent the sounds.



- 5. Hide white board.
- 6. Student pushes the chips in circles, then writes the letter(s) that represent that sound in the boxes.



7. Compare to word written on teacher's white board..
