Mask Mandate-Letter from the Superintendent, 09/04/2021

Please find attached a letter from the Board of School Directors describing the District's position on the mandate and a link to a form to help you navigate exemptions to it should you qualify. If the form applies to your child or you, it should be filled out and turned in to the building principal.

We intend to take every step within our capability to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in our school buildings. Masks will be available for all students for use on school buses and in our buildings. We will implement our Health and Safety Plan in all material respects. That includes maximizing social distancing where feasible, encouraging and promoting good hygiene, and rigorous cleaning and sanitization of the learning environment, among other things. We will continue to work closely with the Department of Health to respond to cases of COVID-19 in our buildings, provide assistance where requested, and seek guidance to best position our schools to control the spread of the virus. We take seriously the responsibility to create a safe and healthy environment for our students and staff and will continue to do so within our operational capability.

Establishing a respectful environment in which students and staff can learn and work is crucial to achieving our shared mission. Therefore, any form of harassment of students or staff related to face coverings or personal viewpoints regarding COVID-19 or any related strategies or mitigation efforts will not be tolerated. Should this occur, immediately report any incident to the building principal.

We expect the information from the Departments of Health and Education will likely change as the school year progresses. Should that occur the district will communicate with you how those changes impact our program and plans. We want our students to enjoy the school year in-person, in their classrooms with their friends and teachers, and will continue to partner with you to ensure we all have a memorable and enjoyable Northern educational experience.

Mask Exemption Forms = submit by email or return document to school

The criteria for mask exemption is outlined in the document below. If your child meets the criteria and you are seeking exemption, please fill out the form, sign and submit to jcal@northernyork.org. Families who have submitted forms will receive an email confirmation of receipt on Monday evening.

We ask that parents fill out and submit these forms because, in order to be in compliance with the Governor's Order, students cannot be allowed to be without a mask on a bus or inside a Northern building without having an exemption form completed. In those instances, students will be asked to put on a mask. If they do not, they will be sent to the office where the administration, student, and parent will discuss the situation.

No school discipline will be enforced on respectful individuals, but without an exemption form, students will be expected to be taken home or will be asked to complete their school work in a designated area. Teachers and other classroom staff do not play a role in granting an exemption, so we appreciate your cooperation as we look to minimize any distraction to the classroom over this matter.

NYCSD Devices Assigned to Students - Please Review and Submit

NYCSD devices are ready for student assignment at school. Children in Grades K-2 will receive an ipad, while Grades 3-5 will receive a chrome book. These devices will be specifically assigned to the student, for use by him/her only. Devices will remain in the classroom and only when in quarantining or remote learning will they be sent home. Students will be taught to care for and be responsible for the safe keeping of their devices at school.

In order for a student to be assigned a device, the parent/guardian must review the technology handbook and choose "Yes" to accept the terms of use, in the Sapphire Parent Portal. Devices will not be assigned to students who do not have this form completed in the Sapphire Parent Portal. With this, we ask families to please sign into the Sapphire Parent Portal account, click on "Student Data Forms," and submit.

Bus Evacuation Drill - An Overview

This month students will participate in two safety drills: Bus Evacuation Drill and Fire Drill

This week, we focus on the **Bus Evacuation Drill.** All drills are mocked to support practice within a safe environment. Drills take place on our school campus. During this drill, bus riders will practice exiting the bus from the rear doors. Two student leaders are assigned to support the exit doors. These student leaders assist their peers in safely exiting the bus, and students are directed to use these steps:

- 1. Doors are assessed for safe exit.
- 2. If the loading doors are safe to exit, the first half of the bus exits in that manner, while the back half of the bus exits from the rear exit.
- 3. Book bags and belonging are left on the bus.
- 4. Students exit by rows.
- 5. The student sits down on the landing of the rear doors when it is his/her turn to exit.
- 6. Student leaders assist by providing physical support from the bus landing.
- 7. Student hops down from the landing with the leader's support.
- 8. Student walks to the quiet line, located away from the road.
- 9. Students voices are off to hear directions.
- 10. Students are situationally alert to the traffic around them.

This week, our students receive specific directions from their bus driver and NES staff assist each bus in practicing safe exit and passenger accounting.

Your partnership is valued as we continue to support and empower our students in creating a safe and secure environment for travel.



Transportation Update

Our Transportation Department has worked this week to shift a few Bus 33 and 34 assignments to vans, seeking to find a solution for the length of time students are on buses.

Our NES Faculty have been working hard to get students loaded and released as soon as possible. Bus 31, 33, 34 are the first buses loaded and released. The remainder of our buses: 16, 20, 14, 19 are loaded and released by 4PM.



Our goal is to streamline further, in an effort to have all buses on the road by 3:50PM. We hope this week affords a more

consistent PM arrival of your children, supporting families in creating a more predictable end of day routine.

At this time, masks are still required for all students on district transportation, unless an exemption is on file.

Time Sensitive: I-I Device Consent

1:1 Technology Acceptance Form, located in <u>Sapphire Parent Portal</u>

The Northern York County School District values the use of technology on instructional

practices and learning. One to one device initiatives require a financial commitment from the

School District, and we are particularly grateful for the priority given to this initiative by Northern York.

- Students in K-2 will be assigned an ipad for use at school.
- Students in 3-5 will be assigned a chomebook for use at school.

With this, the District has posted a1:1 Technology Acceptance Form that parents are to read and sign, after reviewing with their child.

It is important to note: School devices will not be issued until a parent has signed the Student Device Handbook. Any missing 2020-2021 technology must be returned or paid for before student devices are assigned (devices, cords, hot spots, etc.).

To access the 1:1 Technology Acceptance Form, please go to the <u>Sapphire Parent Portal</u> and sign the form electronically. Once in the Sapphire Parent Portal, click on the <u>Student Data</u> <u>Forms</u> link. There, you will find the 1:1 Technology Acceptance Form to read, review, electronically sign, and submit for approval.

Students will receive their school-issued device within the first 8 days of school, following parent completion of the 1:1 Technology Acceptance form in Sapphire and the return or payment of outstanding technology.
