All children are photographed in the Fall and parents opt-into purchasing packages.

September 16: Masks Required - District Information Below

On Thursday, September 16, the District will move forward with an update to our exemption process to ensure we are in compliance with federal law and the face covering order. The Thursday start date allows families time to consider their educational options and pursue the updated exemption process as appropriate.

The updated process will require **medical certification** in order to claim an exemption from wearing a mask. The previous exemption form that was issued on Saturday, September 4 will

no longer be valid after Wednesday, September 15, and will be replaced with the new Section 504/IDEA Exemption Form (linked below):

UPDATED MASK EXEMPTION REQUEST PROCESS

In order to request an exemption to the mask order, Parents/Guardians must: Submit a completed <u>Section 504/IDEA Mask Exemption Request Form</u> to your building principal.

- 1. Please note that available medical records should be submitted along with the 504/IDEA Form. This will enable a multidisciplinary team to determine whether an accommodation is appropriate for your child.
- 2. Each 504/IDEA Form and accompanying records will be reviewed and responded to within five (5) school days.
- 3. Section 504 and IDEA exemptions granted last year (2020-21 school year) will continue to be honored, and a new form does not need to be submitted at this time.

On Thursday, all students who have not applied for and received a medical exception will be expected to comply with the mask mandate within the framework below. If a student is not wearing a mask when they are supposed to, the following procedures will be implemented:

For Sept. 16:

- Students will be reminded to wear a mask.
- A supply of masks will be available in each building.

For Sept. 17 and beyond:

- <u>First Incident</u>: The principal will meet with the student and offer the student a mask. The principal will conference with the student, and a written notice will be given to the student to take home to inform the student's parent/guardian. The principal will attempt to contact the parents.
- <u>Subsequent Incidents</u>: Principals will address the situations according to the building's disciplinary practices.

Families in the process of acquiring the necessary medical certification for a mask exemption that need more time beyond Thursday, September 16, must show proof of a scheduled doctor's appointment to their child's principal.





NYCSD devices are ready for student assignment at school. Children in Grades K-2 will receive an ipad, while Grades 3-5 will receive a chrome book.

These devices will be specifically assigned to the student, for use by him/her only. Devices will remain in the classroom and only when in quarantining or remote learning will they be

sent home. Students will be taught to care for and be responsible for the safe keeping of their devices at school.

In order for a student to be assigned a device, the parent/guardian must review the technology handbook and choose "Yes" to accept the terms of use, in the Sapphire Parent Portal.

Devices will not be assigned to students who do not have this form completed in the Sapphire Parent Portal. With this, we ask families to please sign into the <u>Sapphire Parent Portal</u> account, click on "Student Data Forms," complete and submit.


