Mesh Masks Not Permitted

Dear Northern York County Family,

This communication is to clarify that **mesh masks** do not meet the department of health mask definition. Inquiries/questions should be directed to 1-877-724-3258.

We thank you for your continued partnership as we navigate these unprecedented times.

Physical Education Update

Our Physical Education teachers continue to follow the direction of the mask order, requiring masks indoors, when students are not distanced 6 feet. Our teachers are prioritizing classes outdoors to support mask-free activities. When this is not possible, masks are required if students are close to each other and when movement is not high intensity.

Per the Mask Order, when indoors, masks are off when:

Participating in high intensity aerobic or anaerobic activities, including during a physical education class, in a well-ventilated location and when able to maintain a physical distance of six feet from all other individuals.
