Veteran's Parade, Joyful

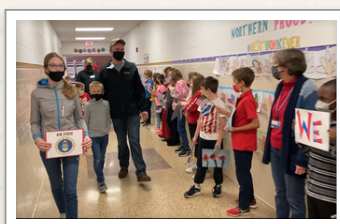
