
I can figure out the surface area of a three-dimensional prism by using a net.

The **surface area** of a solid is the sum of the areas of all of its faces, measured in square units.


A **net** is a two-dimensional representation of a solid.

A **rectangular prism** is a prism with rectangular bases.




A **triangular prism** is a prism with triangular bases.

Find the surface area of the prisms.






