## End of Day Car Rider and Bus Dismissal

Dear Families- Thank you for your kind support and patience over the past several weeks. Our transportation department has worked hard to troubleshoot new routes and iron out the transitions unique to our building. To assist this process, NES has for the past several weeks, started the dismissal process 10 minutes earlier to afford the timely release of students for loading and departure.

We are pleased to report that our school-wide procedures are streamlined and reflect the organized procedures we are accustomed to running each year.

With this, **NES will be shifting to our regular dismissal time starting tomorrow, Monday** 9/27/21.

- Students being picked up by parents at the end of the day (Car Riders) will be dismissed at 3:30PM.
- Students riding a bus or van will be dismissed at 3:40PM for the loading process.
- We anticipate that our buses/vans will depart our campus by 3:50/3:55PM.

This shift should not impact or delay student's arrival home. We appreciate your understanding as the times may shift by a couple minutes at most. Thank you kindly for your continued support.

## Masks Required - District Information Below

The District is officially operating with the expectation of mask wearing by all students, staff and visitors. Families have been provided daily reminders of the process intended and administrators have reached out to individuals to assist in this process.



Any requested exemption will require **medical certification** in order to initiate the 504 process. The previous exemption form that was issued on Saturday, September 4 is no longer valid and families must use the new Section 504/IDEA Exemption Form (Section 504/IDEA Mask Exemption Request Form). This document must be received by the building principal by 09/20/21.

#### Information provided to families on Thursday 09/16/21:

This week Northern York transitioned to the required wearing of masks by students and staff in school. Superintendent Kirkpatrick's message last week served to inform families on the rationale for this requirement and provided the next steps for families seeking medical 504 or IDEA accommodation for their child. As noted in his communication, medical certification is a requirement for this process.

Thursday's communication serves as a reminder to our families of the mask-wearing requirement in school. Staff and students were provided with building-wide announcements reminding of the mask mandate and the opportunity to get one from the nurse/office if they forgot their mask at home.

All students will again be reminded of the mask-wearing requirement. If your child does not have a mask, and the school has not received medical verification for the 504 process, a mask will then be provided to your child. At this point a phone call will be made home to the family.
