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| Huddle | When an offensive team meets before a play to decide on a plan. |
| Kickoff | Used to start a game of football. |
| Quarterback | Position that usually calls the plays and throws the passes is called. |
| Center | Position that hikes the ball to the quarterback and then blocks. |
| Receiver | Position that catches the thrown passes from the quarterback. |
| Defensive Back | The position that covers the receivers when they go out for a pass. |
| Grip-stance-step-throw | The steps to follow in throwing a football properly. |
| Passing | Skill used to get the ball to the receivers on offense. |
| Fumble | If a player drops a ball while running down the field. |
| Interception | When a quarterback throws a pass and it is caught by a player on other team. |
