SCIENCE AND LIVING THINGS

Science:

- Students may enjoy continued exploration of the amphibian group of animals. You can discuss characteristics of the amphibian group of animals –
 - Smooth, wet skin
 - No scales
 - Backbones (vertebrates)
 - Cold-blooded
 - Hatch from eggs
 - Live part of their life in water, part on land
 - go through a life cycle
 - begin with gills, then develop lungs
- Get some fresh air and take a hike/walk to look for signs of Spring – flowers blooming, birds chirping, insects, animals active, etc. Draw a picture, describe the signs you see, share with your family or via See Saw!
- Plant some seeds and watch them grow inside! Keep a picture/drawing journal.
