SIGHT WORDS

Sight Word Practice:

- Practice reading words by playing the game, Memory.
- Encourage children to hunt for sight words in books that are read aloud
- Hide words around the house or in the yard. Have your child go on a scavenger hunt.
- Have your child practice writing the sight words by rainbow writing them. Students trace each word in each of the rainbow colors/
- Write sight words with chalk, whiteboard markers, fun markers, paint, etc.
- Spread shaving cream onto a tray. Have your child write words with their fingers.
- Roll out play dough snakes and make the letters to form each word.
- Use chalk outside to make word lily pads to hop to and from, play hopscotch with words instead of numbers, etc.
- Play tic tac toe using sight words instead of x's and o's.
- Play Bingo using sight words and review words.
