Applicants should write a minimum of 250 words essay, double spaced. The essay should detail the applicant's involvement with the Four Diamonds Fund/mini-thon, what their plans are for the future to continue to raise awareness of pediatric cancer and/or doing fundraising for research and to help children and teens in cancer treatment at Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital and their families.
