Land: **N. America moving north and west**

Life: **fish, plankton, corals, sponges, marine life, insects pollinate new flowering plants, lots of dinosaurs**

Million Years Ago

Land: **N. America moving north**

Life: **sea urchins, sand dollars, green algae, lots of dinosaurs, birds, plants - conifers. ferns.**

Million Years Ago

Land: **N. America, Europe, and Asia began to move north splitting from S. America and Africa**

Life: **green algae, coral, sponges lived in warm waters, ammonites - giant snails, amphibians - frogs, first dinosaurs, and conifers**
