- 1. Puzzle like fit of continental shelves.
  - Ex. Africa and South America fit nearly perfectly.
- 2. Rocks
- Ex. Many rocks from Argentina were identical to those found in South Africa.
- Diamond like rocks found in South Africa and Brazil.
- 3. Fossils certain fossils preserved in rocks of the same age but from different continents.
- Ex. Mesosaurus small fresh water reptile Glossopteris - plant remains found in South America, Australia, Asia, and Africa.
- 4. Coal Beds
- Ex. Coal beds found in North America, Great Britain, and Belgium were deposited during the same time period.
- Form in swampy areas not usually where they are found.
- 5. Climate Found for

Found fossils of trees that normally grow in temperate areas, but today are in a polar climate.
