
A. EVAPORATION




The sun heats up water in oceans, rivers and lakes and turns it into vapor or steam.

*Transpiration - Water seeps from leaves and becomes vapor or steam



B. CONDENSATION



Water vapor in the air gets cold and changes back into liquid, forming clouds.

PRECIPITATION

The air cannot hold the condensed water anymore. The clouds get heavy and water falls back to the Earth as rain, hail or snow.



The water falls back to the oceans, lakes and rivers.
